

HFD EXPLORER SELECTION INTERVIEW

All prospective HFD explorers must pass a selection interview. The interview questions are provided below. Each candidate will have a 15-minute time slot for their interview. They will be graded on a pass/fail basis.

QUESTIONS:

1. Tell us about yourself.

The candidate will have a maximum of 3 minutes to tell the explorer advisors about themselves. The candidate may want to include the following information in a clear and well-prepared statement. Their name, age, where they go to school/where they went to school, a little bit about their background, family, interests, goals, volunteer work and hobbies.

2. Why do you want to be a Henderson Fire Department Explorer?

The candidate will have a maximum of 3 minutes to tell the explorer advisors why they want to be an HFD explorer. The candidates are encouraged to put a lot of thought and preparation into why they want to be an HFD explorer.

3. Feedback

The explorer advisors will have 5 minutes to ask follow up questions and give feedback to the candidates.

INTERVIEW TIPS

- Arrive early
- Dress professionally (Business Casual with dress shoes)
- Clean cut and fresh shave
- Prepare. The questions are provided above.
- Address Explorer Advisors as Sir/Ma'am
- Make eye contact and shake hands
